**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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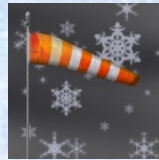
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure taking up residence in the Amundsen Sea region well to the southwest will keep cloudy skies and periods of snow dragging through the area over the next couple of days, as frontal boundaries and troughs take their turns affecting the local area weather. Winds will remain out of the northwest-north throughout the period, with the strongest winds expected later this afternoon into tomorrow morning. Visibility will be up and down as well in periods of snow, with possible mixed precipitation this afternoon as the temperatures warm a bit.
