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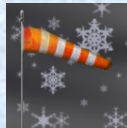
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A series of lows develop in the Bellingshausen Sea and move east continuing to slam into the station. Strong winds and heavy snow continue, bringing visibilities down to near zero at times.
