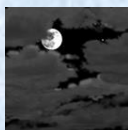
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Fair but cold weather today with patches of fog in the early morning as high pressure dominates the area. Expect that to continue for much of the night tonight – until the winds increase before dawn tomorrow as the pressure gradient tightens in advance of the next low center approaching the peninsula. That system will likewise bring snow to the area beginning tomorrow morning and lasting through the remainder of the day.
