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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

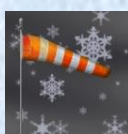
Pressure falls and winds increase throughout the day, with gusts approaching hurricane force this evening as the next storm arrives from the west. This will bring snow, too, and all that will combine to reduce visibility significantly, especially overnight tonight. Expect conditions to improve gradually tomorrow. On a positive note, temperatures will rise throughout this period, with tonight likely warmer than today.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-2 in snow, blowing snow, occasionally < 1

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10, becoming N and increasing through the day to 40-45 gusts to 65

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -16°C / 2°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility(SM): 1-3 in snow, blowing snow, occasionally < 1

Wind (kts): N 40-45 gusts to 55 becoming N 30-40

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 in snow, blowing snow becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): W-N 15-25 gusts to 35 early

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
