PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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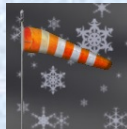
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The barrage of low pressure systems is thinning out a bit, but not going away just yet. The strong winds and heavy snow will taper off later tonight, providing a temporary break tomorrow. Light snow will occasionally continue to fall, and temperatures will cool again without the strong northerly winds. But we're not entirely out of the woods just yet!
