PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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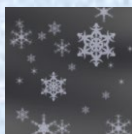
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A large low pressure system is on approach from the Bellingshausen Sea. The precursory wind, snow, and mist will continue today, but tomorrow will see conditions deteriorate. Gusty winds and heavier snow are expected. With temperatures already around the melting point, along with an expected warming trend, some sleet will be mixed in with the snow from this system.
