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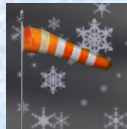
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The incoming low pressure system continues to slowly advance, ramping up winds and snowfall into the evening. Tonight and tomorrow will see the worst of the weather, with conditions improving around midday. Warm temperatures will also allow for a bit of sleet.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 3-5 due to light snow, sleet, and mist

Wind (kts): NE 10-15 occasional gusts to 25

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, becoming 1/2-2 due to snow, sleet, and mist

Wind (kts): NW 15-25, gusting to 30

Min Temp: -2°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1/2-2 due to snow, sleet, and mist, becoming 4-6 due to light snow, sleet, and mist

Wind (kts): NW 15-25, gusting to 30, becoming light and variable

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
