REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The low has some last few punches to throw today, then tomorrow weakens appreciably as it enters the Drake. Expect strong storm-force winds to start the day, then gradual and steady decreasing speed through this period, with something of a break in precipitation intensity tonight followed by an uptick tomorrow.

Wind (kts): NE 25-35 gust 55 becoming NW-NE 15-25

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 4-6 in snow
