**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Fair weather continues to dominate, but change is coming. A minor trough moves in later tonight, bringing clouds and very light snow. As the parent low pressure moves in closer tomorrow, winds will pick up, temperatures will rise, and the snow/sleet mix will become heavier.

**Sky:** Partly Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** Light & variable

**Max Temp:** -3°C / 27°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 3 – 5 due to light snow and mist

**Wind (kts):** Light & variable

**Min Temp:** -4°C / 25°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 3-5 due to light snow, sleet, and mist, becoming 2 – 4

**Wind (kts):** Light & variable, becoming NE 10 – 20, w/ occasional gusts to 30

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F
