**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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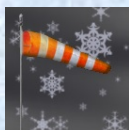
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Steady west-northwesterly flow will continue to bring occasional waves of precipitation into the Anvers Island region over the next couple of days. Cloudy skies and periods of reduced visibility in snow continue through Monday. The next major Low moves in from the northwest on Tuesday with a significant increase in winds and precipitation.
