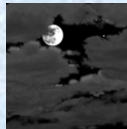
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

As one low passes through the area today another follows closely behind, looking set to move fairly steadily across the northern Peninsula from west to east along much the same track as the first. As of now winds associated with this feature do not appear to be particularly strong, so expect reasonable weather today, then a bit heavier snow pre-dawn and through the day tomorrow.
