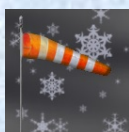
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The ridge departs today, and a low moves in from behind it. Unlike the previous examples this one is moving more north to south; instead of passing through the Drake it's taking aim at the northern peninsula. It will bring snow, of course, but the main impact at Palmer will be a return of storm-force wind gusts tonight into tomorrow morning, though that same northerly flow will likewise raise the air temperature back up to above freezing.
