REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low center number one for this period appears to be significantly weaker than previously anticipated as far as impacts on Palmer Station go, which is good news. Less good news is that there's a low number two following behind it, now expected to bring those storm-force winds to town tomorrow instead of today. (Unfortunately the warming trend will also be delayed by a day.)
