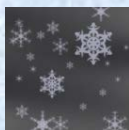
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A weak, elongated low pressure trough stretches north-south across the Drake. With very little pressure gradient through the area winds will become generally light after an initial gusty period concludes, but snowfall continuous (if intermittent) for most of the next two days.
