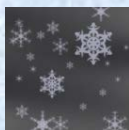
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure trough remains in place across the Drake, thus the established weather pattern persists today: cloudy conditions, generally light winds, and snowfall of varying intensity. Tonight through tomorrow a low passing southward to the east of the peninsula should shift area winds to a southeasterly flow.
