**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

As a southward-moving low departs today, a ridge approaches the area tonight. Expect increasingly light and variable winds, snow mostly ending over night, and glimpses of blue skies tomorrow. A low approaching from the southeast will likely cut short that period of fair weather, with snow likely to resume around sunset tomorrow.

**Visibility (SM):** 3-5 in snow, occasionally < 1 in snow, fog

**Wind (kts):** Variable 5-10 occasionally SE 10-15

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 4-6 in snow, fog becoming unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** Variable 5-10

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Partly Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Variable in patchy AM fog becoming unrestricted, snow late

**Wind (kts):** Variable 5-10

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -7°C / 19°F
