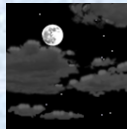
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Initially gusty winds begin to dissipate today, snow ends and another period of fair weather begins as the current low center moves off to the northeast, a ridge builds in from the northwest and high pressure dominates the area.
