A low center bound for the southern peninsula will drive a trough across Anvers Island today, bringing snow and gusty winds to Palmer Station. The moisture flow will continue overhead after it passes, keeping snow in the forecast throughout this period. The pressure gradient will likewise remain tight, so gusty winds will persist, too.
