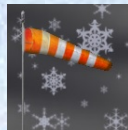
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A pair of troughs from the low to the west strike the area; the first late today and the second before noon tomorrow. Snow and strong winds will accompany both, without much real relief from either overnight tonight. The second appears to be the more significant snow-maker, both in duration and rate of fall.
