**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

One final brush with a trough and then high pressure dominates – at least for a little while. Things will remain a bit on the windy and wet side today into tonight, then the winds die down before morning and the snow ends shortly thereafter. A low in the Bellingshausen will initiate a change in wind direction and an uptick in speed later tomorrow, but does not appear to be a significant threat at this time.
