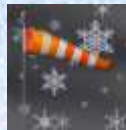
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

High pressure still sits over the region today, but conditions are beginning to transition in the form of increased cloudiness as it moves out into the Drake. Low pressure from the west will start making its presence known overnight as winds increase and snow begins with the approaching frontal zone.
