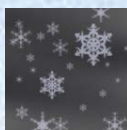
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The Antarctic Peninsula will be between low pressure systems today, with lows to the north, east, and southwest of Palmer. A frontal system will approach from the west Saturday afternoon, and will be accompanied by increasing winds and milder temperatures.
