**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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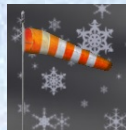
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

There will be a brief lull in the winds and snow early today, followed by increasing winds and snow rates as a large and powerful low pressure system approaches the southern Antarctic Peninsula. A cold front will pass through Palmer tomorrow morning, followed by decreasing winds and snow rates, as well as slightly cooling temperatures.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2-4 in snow and mist, becoming mainly 1 or less

**Wind (kts):** NW-N 15-25, becoming N 25-35 with gusts to 45

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1 or less in snow and mist

**Wind (kts):** N 35-45, gusts to 55

**Min Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 14°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1 or less in snow and mist, becoming 4-6 late

**Wind (kts):** N 30-40 with gusts to 55, becoming NW 15-20

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 14°F
