**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Gusty winds and snow are expected to continue throughout most of the next two days, as multiple low pressure systems slam the Antarctic Peninsula. Snow and cloud cover may improve for some of the day tomorrow under a weak ridge between the lows, but winds will persist in a tight pressure gradient even during that time.
