PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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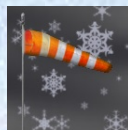
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea will continue to produce strong northerly winds and snow over the station. Winds will shift to the northwest and diminish slightly by Thursday morning with temperatures cooling through the day.
