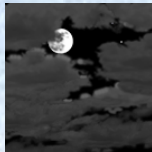
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Southwest flow likely to move areas of fog through today with a weak low pressure center swinging wide to the west clouding things up by evening. Expect a beautiful tomorrow as the low tumbles harmlessly east through Drake's Passage, returning a loose pressure pattern to the peninsula...
