### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

While high pressure remains the dominant regime over the region, satellite and model data show a large swath of low stratus coming in from the southwest. The increased cloudiness is expected to produce snow, which will intensify overnight before rapidly clearing tomorrow morning.
