REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A broad low pressure system will linger in the Bellingshausen Sea through tomorrow, bringing a fairly consistent barrage of winds and cloudiness to the area. Precipitation will be on and off, but given the warm temperatures from the north, expect mostly wet sleet.
