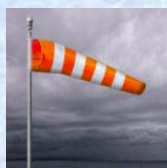

REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Broad low pressure remains in the Bellingshausen Sea and will bring a more vigorous frontal boundary crashing the peninsula early tomorrow morning with winds peaking in the 35-45 knot range. Expect generally good visibility with restrictive periods of rain and fog...
