REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Wavy northwest flow continues around broad low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea. Expect high winds this morning as a frontal boundary crashes the peninsula. Stratus, fog and, likely, mixed precipitation settles in for the afternoon and evening. Some clearing and warming tomorrow as a weaker boundary strikes the area...
