REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Wavy northwest flow continues off the deep South Pacific bringing rain and warm temperatures. Conditions today will be breezy with periods of precipitation, possibly mixed, and fog late afternoon, early evening. A vigorous frontal boundary to crash the area tomorrow morning bringing strongest winds early and plenty of rain throughout the day...

Visibility (SM): 3-5 rain, occasional Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE 35-50, becoming N-NE 20-35
