A ridge of high pressure slides through today with generally fair conditions marred only by patchy areas of fog and stratus from the southwest. Expect increasing clouds overnight with warmer temperatures tomorrow as another frontal boundary approaches, crashing the area late afternoon, evening with high wind and rain showers...
