REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Big ol' low pressure moving into the Bellingshausen Sea to sweep a frontal boundary across the area this afternoon through early evening bringing higher winds, warmer temperatures, and rain showers. Expect winds to ease overnight with dreary conditions of precipitation, possibly mixed, and fog under an extensive cloud field through the end of the forecast period...Happy Holidays!

Wind (kts): N-NE 7-15, becoming NE 20-35

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-3 rain showers, becoming ½-2 fog, snow, rain/snow mixed

Wind (kts): NE 25-40, becoming W-NW 10-20

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 fog, light snow, rain/snow mixed

Wind (kts): SW-W 12-22, easing to SW-W 5-10

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F
