PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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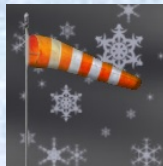
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Strong Low pressure east of the Peninsula, along with a decent southwesterly flow up into the Anvers Island region will keep periods of light snow/mist over the area well into Thursday, as a fairly strong ridge of High pressure builds in from the west-northwest. Temperatures cool off throughout the period as well.
