PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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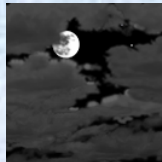
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Transient high pressure should push an area of stratus and fog, at times dense, through the area today. Clouds may break early this evening as the high pressure moves east and low pressure advances. Expect warm temperatures and rising wind tomorrow with rain by evening as a frontal complex crashes the coast.

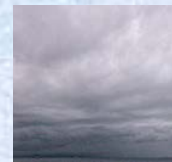

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 fog, light snow, occasional 3-5 fog

Wind (kts): W-NW 5-10, becoming Variable 5

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 fog, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Variable 5, becoming NE 5-10

Min Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -2°C / 28°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 rain; rain turning to snow overnight

Wind (kts): NE 7-15, becoming NE-SE 25-45 gust 50

Max Temp: 7°C / 45°F

Min Wind Chill: -3°C / 27°F
