

REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The track of the Lows moving through the region have taken more of a west-east pattern moving through the Drake Passage to the north, so for today, things should remain fairly dry, although still cloudy. Weak troughing moves through the area overnight tonight and tomorrow, with the likelihood of occasional snow flurries passing through as well, which will reduce visibility at times. Temperatures remain on the cool side.
