**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure approaching from the west today keeps cloudy skies and occasional periods of light rain in over the area, changing over to snow later tonight into tomorrow morning. Winds intensify throughout the day and remain strong into late morning tomorrow. Visibility will remain fairly decent throughout. The Low passes to the north tomorrow as it moves off to the east-northeast, with a chance for a peek or two at the sun occasionally tomorrow.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted w/ periods of 3-5 light rain, occasional 2-4 possible

**Wind (kts):** E 25-50 w/ gusts to 60 possible

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional 4-6 light snow

**Wind (kts):** E 25-35 w/ gusts to 45, becoming 10-20 by morning

**Min Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -6°C / 21°F

**Sky:** Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, w/ light snow developing early evening

**Wind (kts):** E-SE 10-20, Light & Variable late morning, then SW 10-20 late evening

**Max Temp:** 3°C / 37°F
