Low pressure remains in the Bellingshausen Sea region which will keep cloudy skies and periods of light snow in the area into Sunday evening, with occasional periods of reduced visibility in snow as well, mainly tonight into late morning on Sunday. A tightened pressure gradient moves in over the area by late morning today, continuing into Sunday morning before things begin to ease considerably.
