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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

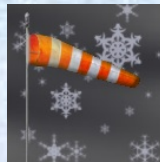
Low pressure remains in the Bellingshausen Sea region which will keep cloudy skies and periods of light snow in the area into Sunday evening, with occasional periods of reduced visibility in snow as well, mainly tonight into late morning on Sunday. A tightened pressure gradient moves in over the area by late morning today, continuing into Sunday morning before things begin to ease considerably.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional periods of light snow

Wind (kts): Light / Variable, becoming NW-N 5-15 w/ isolated gusts to 20 late morning

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 4-6 in light snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-20, becoming 15-30 w/ gusts to 35

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted w/ occasional light snow, brief periods of 2-4

Wind (kts): N-NE 15-20 w/ gusts to 25, becoming NW-N 5-10

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
