**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Stiff southeasterly flow breaks down as low pressure now at the northern tip of the peninsula continues east. Expect wind speeds to ease through afternoon, evening as a weak low pressure trough settles over the peninsula for the remainder of the period. Skies remain generally fair today with increased clouds and a chance of fog by tomorrow evening...
