Weak low pressure moving east will drag light precipitation across the area this morning. A field of fog and stratus – and a little bit of light snow thrown in – will move in tonight through tomorrow ahead of a transient ridge of high pressure. Expect wind on the light side for the forecast period, and visibility becoming generally poor by this evening...
