**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure remains stretched out over the area in a southwest-northeast orientation for the next couple of days, keeping cloudy skies and periods of reduced visibility in light rain/snow/fog in the forecast into Tuesday morning. Gusty easterly winds pound the region this morning into this afternoon, diminishing by early evening. Temperatures cool Tuesday into Wednesday.
