### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure remains stretched out over the area in a west-southwest to northeast orientation for the next couple of days, keeping cloudy skies and relatively light winds over the region for today and tonight, as the precipitation remains to the north of Anvers Island. Precipitation moves down over the area by Wednesday morning with periods of reduced visibility expected once again into Thursday.
