

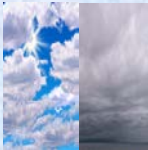

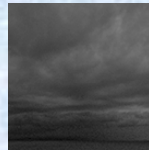
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak low pressure continues to span the northern half of the peninsula...A minor boundary should move through tonight bringing increased clouds and light snow. Expect greater influence from east of the peninsula tomorrow with decreasing cloudiness and good visibility...
