PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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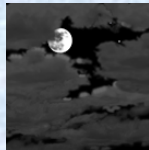
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak Low pressure remains to the west of Anvers Island this morning, keeping cloudy skies, a chance of light snow and light winds in the forecast for today. The Low pulls off to the north-northeast tonight into tomorrow morning, allowing weak High pressure to take control of the region. Clearing skies, good visibility and weak winds will be in place for Saturday, with the next system expected to roll in late Sunday night into Monday.
