REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak High pressure remains in control of the region today as a Low pressure system approaches from the west tomorrow, keeping things decent again today for a change. Winds will remain light with decent visibility into tomorrow evening, when the possibility of some late night snow/fog increases significantly. Temperatures will remain on the cooler side through tomorrow.
