A weak ridge of High pressure extending down over the area from the north quickly moves off to the east, as the first of many waves of precipitation roll in from the west this morning, with periods of reduced visibility in fog/snow. A deepening Low digs into the Bellingshausen Sea region by tomorrow morning with an associated frontal boundary sweeping out ahead of it, bringing periods of significantly reduced visibility in rain/snow/fog into Friday. Temperatures warm significantly tomorrow.
