Low pressure systems on either side of the Peninsula this morning keeping cloudy skies, strengthened north-northeasterly winds and reduced visibility in rain / fog over the area into tomorrow morning. By Monday morning, Low pressure stretches out in a west-east fashion through the Drake Passage and down over Anvers Island, keeping reduced visibilities in a mix of snow / rain into the evening hours.
