REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure remains stretched out through the Drake Passage again today with a Low situated just to the west of Anvers Island as well. Expect cloudy skies, diminishing northeasterly winds and periods of light rain (changing over to snow late night) in the area into tomorrow afternoon. The Low pressure pulls out to the northeast throughout the day tomorrow as a ridge of High pressure builds in from the west-northwest, bringing dense fog in over the area into Wednesday morning.
