PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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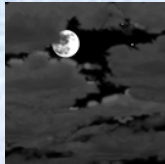
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weakening low pressure moving northeast through the Bellingshausen Sea will merge over the northern part of the peninsula with a rare frontal wave from the northeast tomorrow afternoon, evening. Expect mild but breezy conditions today with the wind dying over night through tomorrow. Expect deteriorating visibility by tomorrow afternoon through evening in fog and snow as low pressure envelopes the Palmer area...
